

CONSENT TO DISCLOSURE OF TAX RETURN INFORMATION

D A Harden CPA, (“we,” “us,” and “our”)

Federal law requires this consent form be provided to you (“you” refers to each taxpayer, if more than one). Unless authorized by law, we cannot disclose, without your consent, your tax information to third parties for purposes other than the preparation and filing of your tax return. If you consent to the disclosure of your tax return information, Federal law may not protect your tax return information from further use or distribution.

You are not required to complete this form. If we obtain your signature on this form by conditioning our services on your consent, your consent will not be valid. If you agree to the disclosure of your tax return information, your consent is valid for the amount of time that you specify. If you do not specify the duration of your consent, your consent is valid for one year.

You have indicated that you are interested in applying for an Electronic Refund Check or Electronic Refund Deposit (collectively, an “e-Collect product”) from EPS Financial, LLC (“EPS”). In order to have your e-Collect product application evaluated and processed, we, along with EPS, must disclose all of your 2018 tax return information necessary for evaluating the request to the Bancorp Bank (“Bancorp”) and Galileo Processing, Inc (“Galileo”). You may request a more limited disclosure of tax return information, but you will not be eligible to submit an application for an e-Collect product.

If you would like us to disclose your 2023 tax return information for this purpose, please sign and date your consent to the disclosure of your tax return information.

By signing below, you (including each of you if there is more than one taxpayer) authorize us to disclose to EPS, Bancorp and Galileo all of your 2023 tax return information necessary so that they can evaluate and process your application for an e-Collect product. You understand that if you are not willing to authorize us to share your tax information on with EPS, Bancorp and Galileo, you will not be able to obtain an e-Collect product, but you can still choose to have your tax return prepared and filed by us for a fee.
